Memorandum

A League official who works as a security trust agent to track international changes has submitted the following accounts of his exploits in Russia during the second fortnight of July:-

25th July, 1939

Two Focke-Wulf Condor aircrafts were seen landing in a private airstrip near Moscow. The Private airstrip is often used to ferry Stalin's close aides in and out of Moscow in a clandestine manner. The Two aircrafts are of German make and represent insignias of diplomats, officers and journalists.

28th July, 1939

An officer wearing Nazi uniform who resembled Herr Ribbentrop was spotted from a window into the office of Alexander Poskrebyshv. Poskrebyshv is Joseph Stalin's chief of personal chancellery.

Insignia which shows both the Soviet hammer and sickle embroidered next to the Nazi swastika was also recovered from trash heaps of the NKVD.

30th July, 1939

Vyacheslav Molotov was seen entering the Red Square entertaining a group of German guests. Further intelligence gathered from the residence of Boris Shaposhnikov's residence points towards a dividing up of European territories between the USSR and Germany.

The bilateral relations between Germany and USSR seem to be getting dangerously Cordial and may point to a further escalation of armaments and armed invasion of sovereign territories similar to that of the Czechoslovakian occupation by Germany.

The date is 1st August 1939, The League of Nations (Council) must meet and deliberate on a possible redressal to any such belligerent plannings. If the USSR and Nazi Germany make a diplomatic truce and formulate plans to militarily occupy Europe, it would spell inevitable war for the entire League at Large
